

## HURRICANE IRMA UPDATE

Saturday 9/9/17 - 9am  
Update from NOAA

Overall, we are still expecting fringe impacts, especially in the onshore fetch between high pressure to the north and Irma's circulation well to the south. This fetch will likely lead to coastal flooding, especially during each high tide Monday. If this trend continues then a Coastal Flood Advisory or Coastal Flood Warning may be needed. In addition, a High Surf Advisory may be needed to account for increasing breakers in the surf zone. Inlet entrances could be particularly dangerous as well, especially during the falling tide when the current is counter to the large incoming wave energy causing very steep waves.

Please stay alert and be prepared.

**In preparation for these weather conditions over the weekend we are asking all property owners to secure their trash cans immediately after collection on Saturday and Monday to help prevent these cans from being overturned and trash blowing in our streets and right of ways.**
