



## Potential Tropical Cyclone “Ten”

The track now takes the center of the storm near the SC/NC coast later today then increases speed to the northeast during Tuesday. Strengthening is possible as this storm moves by the Cape Fear area and more-so as it moves away from the area.

A **Flash Flood Watch** is now in effect for our area until Tuesday Morning and a **Tropical Storm Watch** is in place adjacent to coastal waters in Brunswick, New Hanover, Pender, Horry and Georgetown. A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect adjacent to offshore water beyond twenty nautical miles.

The rainfall threat has increased with the potential for around **six inches of rainfall** along coastal areas through Tuesday morning. Hazardous maritime conditions are expected for boaters and swimmers with **rough seas, steep waves especially in the vicinity of inlet entrances and strong rip currents.**

The wind threat is elevated mainly along the coastal areas with potential peak winds estimated at **48 MPH**. Winds are expected to begin this evening for the northeast SC coastal areas and late evening into Tuesday morning for the southeast NC coastal areas.

Remember you should not focus on the exact track of the storm as impacts can occur well outside the forecast cone. Please begin to make the necessary preparations for this storm.

We are requesting that all polycarts be returned to the dwelling as soon as possible after trash collection today due to possibility of strong winds. We will update this message as new information becomes available.

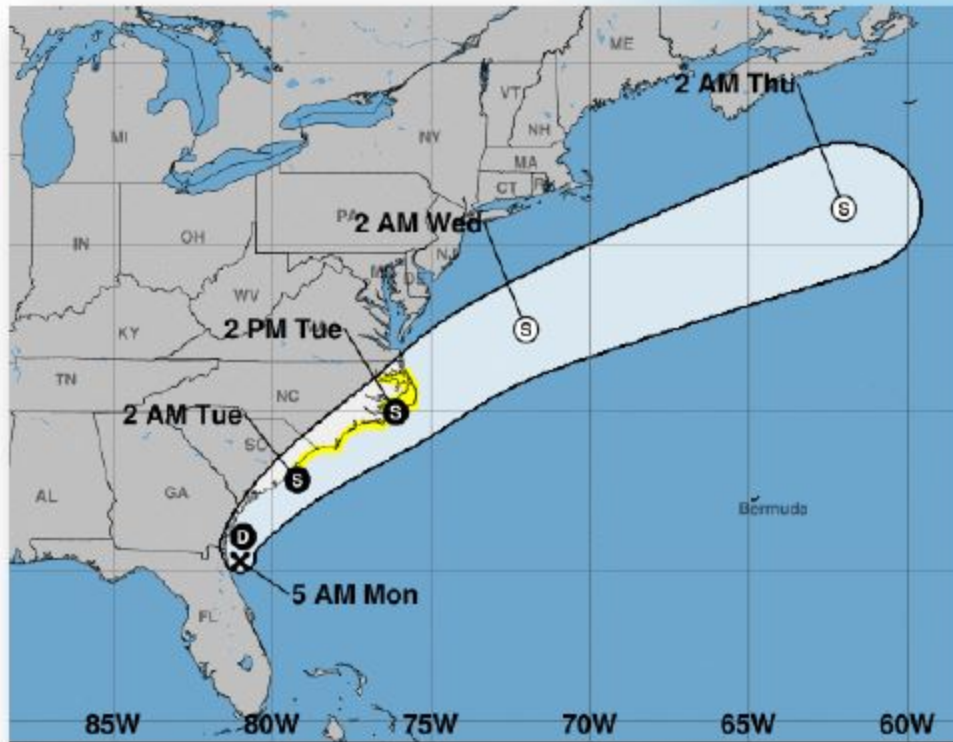

✓ Remember, you should not focus on the exact track of the storm as impacts can occur well outside the forecast cone.

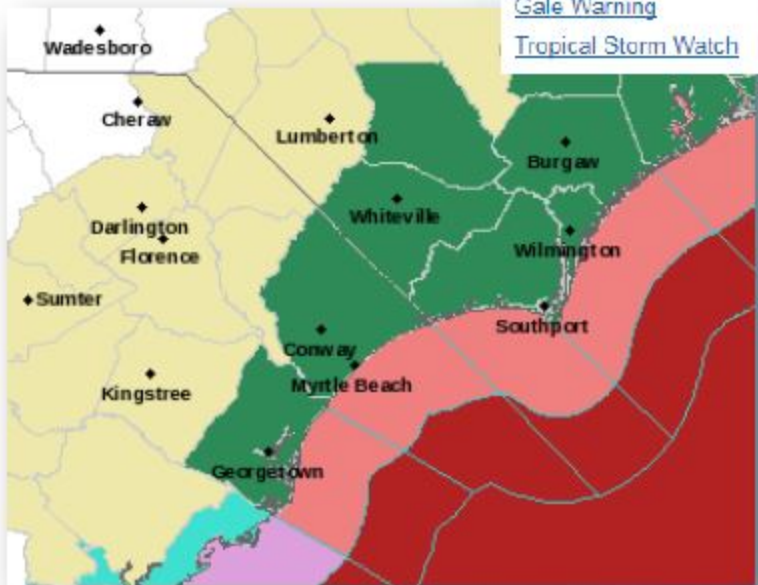


NHC Potential Tropical Cyclone 10 Advisory #3 Days 1-3 valid 5 AM EDT Monday Aug 28, 2017
